Iowa Holstein Association Annual Meeting Minutes

President Dan Moon called the annual meeting of the Iowa Holstein Association to order on February 25, 2023, at PromiseLand Winery, Guttenberg, Iowa. President Moon welcomed all in attendance along with special guest Tim Ziemba and Dennis DeVore. The minutes of the 2022 annual meeting were approved along with the operating statement for 2022.

Audit Committee Chair Walt Wessel reported that the committee reviewed the financial records of the association, and they were in good order and correct and stated he had copies of materials if anyone had questions.

President Moon's comments on the past year as President of the Association were to thank the employees and encourage adult members to invite the younger adults to become active. The association as a whole is doing well.

The Nominating Committee was motioned to cast a unanimous ballot and was approved.

District 1-27, District 2-7, District 4-2, District 5-0 District 6-0, District 8-12, District 9-0.

Membership

The adult membership base fee is \$35 with an additional \$1 per registered/identified cow on 1/1 that year, with a maximum cow fee of \$200. A membership update was mailed to membership workers in February. Membership postcards were sent to members not renewed in March. Membership invitations are sent to those who do business with the National Association but are not State Association members. There is a \$10 late fee assessed to past members if not paid by March 1.

The district rebates of 30% were figured on the membership count as of March 1, 2022. The rebate structure has changed. Each district will receive a 10% rebate, districts hosting a district show each year will receive an additional 10% with an additional 5% to each district hosting a state show and/or convention with the appropriate rotations.

In 2020 it was changed to be entitled to one district director, there must be 30 or more farmer or retired farmer members in the district based on the previous year's membership. The number of directors-at-large increased to three from seven starting in 2007. Districts 5, 6, 9 and 10 no longer have a district director, but anyone from those districts interested in serving as a director-at-large is encouraged to be a candidate for one of those positions. In addition to the regular directors, the voting members of each district may elect additional directors based on the following schedule of paid farmer and retired farmer memberships in the Association within the district as of August 1 of each year preceding the year for which elected.

60 to 100 members = 1 additional director
101 to 200 members = 2 additional directors
201 to 300 members = 3 additional directors

If at any time, you would like Association information and an invitation to join sent to a prospective member let the treasurer know and it will be done.
